NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the Holt County Clerk until March 29, 2019 at 11:30 a.m., for the construction of an asphaltic concrete overlay project. The project is referred to as “O’Neill East Overlay, C-45(518)” and includes approximately 1,350 feet of 2” cold milling and 2” asphalt overlay, type “SPR” and approximately 10.9 miles cold milling and 3” asphalt overlay, type “SPR”. The project is located beginning at the intersection of State Hwy 20 and Old Co. Hwy 108 in O’Neill and continues northeast and east to the intersection of 504th Avenue and 872nd Road in Holt County, Nebraska.

This project shall include all labor, materials, transportation and equipment required for asphaltic concrete overlay and patching, type “SPR”, cold milling, earth shoulder construction, seeding, permanent pavement markings and related incidental work.

Copies of the Bid Documents and Specifications are open to public inspection at the office of the Holt County Highway Superintendent, 1806 108 Road O’ Neill, Nebraska 68763. All Bid Proposals must be submitted on the forms furnished with the Bid Documents.

The sealed bids may be mailed or delivered to the Holt County Clerk, P.O. Box 329, 204 N. 4th St., O’Neill, NE 68763 and should be plainly marked as, “Construction Bid Proposal – O’Neill East Overlay, C-45(518)”. The Bids will be opened at 11:30 a.m., March 29, 2019.

Along with its Bid Proposal, each bidder shall submit an unconditional Bid Bond or Certified Check payable to the County Treasurer of Holt County, Nebraska, in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the Bid Proposal. Also, each bidder is to provide a Start of Construction date and End of Construction date with its Bid Proposal. The desired completion date is October 31, 2019. The successful bidder (i.e. Contractor) will be allowed sixty (60) calendar days, after beginning work, provided they do not exceed their specified End of Construction date.

Within ten (10) days following the award of the Contract, the successful bidder shall furnish a surety bond or bonds in an amount equal to or greater than the full amount of the contract. The surety and form of the bonds are subject to acceptance by the Holt County Board of Supervisors.

Holt County, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Dept of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally assisted programs of the Dept of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, sex, age and disability/handicap in consideration for award.

The Holt County Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities in bids received. Award of the Contract will be in accordance with the County Purchasing Act’s competitive bidding considerations as set forth in Neb.Rev.Stat. §§ 23-3110 to 23-3114.
